

PRU PLACEMENT 2020 – guide to referrals & PRU turnaround places in KS2

REFERRAL

- SPR completed by school requesting PRU turnaround placement following review meeting by a member of the outreach team.
- Reviewed MSP and supporting documents considered by EAT SENDCo prior to SPR panel.
- Placement decision made by SPR panel (SPR is chaired by mainstream head teachers).
- SPR updated to share allocation of place (Synergy Database).

** If outreach support is not already in place in school this could be allocated as a first step.*

PLANNING

- School contact Engage Academy to arrange an admission meeting – this must include parent, school, other professionals involved and Engage staff.
- What is aim/focus of placement?
- What is the exit plan?
- PRU start / exit date agreed.

Link teacher from mainstream school identified, please note there is an expectation that schools will visit/work with the child during placement.

REVIEWS

School remain responsible for the coordination of the MSP under the 'assess, plan, do, review' process.

EXIT

- Exit meeting attended by school, parents and other professionals to agree reintegration timetable into mainstream school.
- Engage reintegration support plan is completed and made available for all professionals and parents.

Reintegration support is limited to two weeks from Engage (part time). Additional support can be requested through the submission of an SPR for outreach support.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Review meetings between schools convened every 6 weeks (parent/child are present).
- Mainstream school manage the MSP review process with contributions from PRU staff.
- EHCP Assessment, if applicable, completed by mainstream school.
- PRU turnaround placements are 12 weeks.
