

PRU PLACEMENT 2020 – guide to referrals & PRU places in KS4

REFERRAL

- SPR completed by school requesting PRU placement.
- Reviewed MSP and supporting documents considered by Head Teacher and SENDCo prior to SPR panel.
- Placement decision made by SPR panel (SPR is chaired by secondary head teachers)
- SPR updated to share allocation of place (Synergy Database).

*Once allocated, Pupils are dual registered during their placement with the referring school being the 'main' and Ethos College being the 'subsidiary' setting.

PLANNING

- Planning meeting convened with pupil, parent / carer, school and any other professionals (may be in the referring school, Ethos College or pupil's home).
- Parents and pupil visit Ethos College (supported by referring school staff).
- Baseline assessments undertaken.
- Start date agreed.
- My Support Plan / EHCP updated.

EXIT

- Pupils generally remain at Ethos until the end of KS4.
- We prepare and support young people for the transition to post-16 education, employment or training.
- Close links with C & K Careers to support in the application stage and transition into further education, employment or training.
