

# PRU PLACEMENT 2020 – guide to referrals & PRU turnaround places in KS3

## REFERRAL

- SPR completed by school requesting PRU turnaround placement.
- Reviewed MSP and supporting documents considered by EAT SENDCo prior to SPR panel.
- Placement decision made by SPR panel (SPR is chaired by secondary head teachers)
- SPR updated to share allocation of place (Synergy Database).
- Placement decision shared with BACS (North / South) to ensure data is captured.

*\* Outreach support in school is often allocated as a first step (all cases are 'shared' at BACS to monitor referrals)*

## PLANNING

- School contact Reach Academy to arrange an admission meeting – this must include parent, school, other professionals involved and Reach staff.
  - What is aim/focus of placement?
  - What is the exit plan?
  - PRU start / exit date agreed

*Link teacher from mainstream school identified, please note there is an expectation that schools will visit/work with the child during placement.*

## REVIEWS

School remain responsible for the coordination of the MSP under the 'assess, plan, do, review' process.

## EXIT

- Exit meeting attended by school, parents and other professionals to agree reintegration timetable into mainstream school.
- Reach exit report is completed and made available for all professionals & parents.

Reintegration support is limited to two weeks from Reach (part time). Additional support can be requested through the submission of an SPR for Outreach support.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Review meetings between schools convened every 6 weeks (parent/child are present).
- Mainstream school manage the MSP review process with contributions from PRU staff.
- EHCP Assessment, if applicable, completed by mainstream school.
- PRU Turnaround placements are 12 weeks.
